Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR)

At Canon, we are committed to supporting compliance with applicable EU requirements on packaging and waste. The Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR), which replaces Directive 94/62/EC, establishes a harmonised framework to reduce packaging waste, improve recyclability and reuse, increase recycled content, and introduce harmonised labelling and information requirements across the single market. In addition, PPWR forms a key part of the EU's transition towards a circular economy.

The information in this factsheet reflects Canon's current understanding and is provided for general guidance only. As legislation and requirements may change, the content may not be comprehensive or applicable to all circumstances. Readers should consider this information alongside other relevant sources when making decisions.

Compliance Approach

- All Canon packaging currently placed on the EU market continues to comply with existing applicable legislation, including Directive 94/62/EC and relevant national requirements.
- Canon is preparing to meet PPWR requirements in line with applicable timelines.
- Our approach aligns with the phased implementation of PPWR and takes into account the development of delegated acts, harmonised standards, and technical guidance.

Declarations of Conformity

- Canon is establishing, and will maintain, PPWR compliant Declarations of Conformity.
- These declarations will be made available where required and in accordance with PPWR's applicability.
- Internal processes are already in place to ensure appropriate documentation, traceability, and regulatory readiness.

Material and Sustainability Information

Canon is preparing to ensure that relevant packaging information is made available where required. This may include (non-exhaustive):

- Material composition and identification
- Recyclability and recycling-related information
- Reusability information, where applicable
- Recycled content, where relevant
- Applicable labelling information

Canon continues to monitor regulatory developments to support timely and accurate implementation across relevant markets.

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
